


In this webcast, "Printing Games, Power Search Quizzes & Categories by Game," we will cover:


- Printing games for moderators to pre-read & the tournament director to have during your campus tournament

# **Printing Power Searches**

Open the HCASC Game Play Database and accept the license agreement. You will see the Main Switchboard.

- On the right hand side as highlighted here are the Power Search quizzes and the answer sheets.
- There are 10 Power Searches, each with its own answer sheet.
- Select the documents you wish to print from the list, one at a time and click the Print icon.



## Print games & other reports

- On the left hand side are the games.
- Select the games you wish to print from the list and then click the related document you wish to print:
  - Questions By Game. These are used by the moderators to preread games and by the tournament director in the event of any game discrepancies.
  - Games without Answers. These are used in HCASC Academic Club and NCT Team practice sessions to assess players' knowledge.
  - Categories By Game. These sheets are used in the campus tournament to have the players indicate in which round they will be in the center position answering Face-Off questions.
